AI Policy Overview

New Mexico lawmakers have yet to prioritize artificial intelligence policies broadly. However, the House Science, Technology & Telecommunications Committee <u>held a meeting</u> in July 2023 that covered the impact of Al on civil liberties, criminal justice, and its use in spreading misinformation. The Committee <u>met again</u> in November 2023 to discuss transparency in AI. In 2024, lawmakers enacted a political deepfake bill into law.

Deepfakes

In 2024, New Mexico enacted a law (<u>NM HB 182</u>) to require a political advertisement generated in whole or in part by using artificial intelligence to include a disclaimer. The law makes it a violation of the Campaign Reporting Act if the distribution occurs within 90 days of an election.

Legislative & Regulatory History
