## **AI Policy Overview**

West Virginia lawmakers have yet to prioritize artificial intelligence policies broadly. However, the Joint Standing Committee <u>held a hearing</u> on May 8, 2023, on emerging trends in AI. Lawmakers raised concerns about the supply chain of AI and whether foreign technology could compromise state systems.

In 2024, West Virginia enacted a law (<u>WV HB 5690</u>) to create a West Virginia Task Force on Artificial Intelligence within the governor's office.
